


Camille Rayon

Golfe-Juan is a picturesque seaside town on the French Riviera, nestled between Cannes and Antibes. Known for its stunning Mediterranean coastline and the bustling Port Camille Rayon, it's a prime spot for people seeking sun, sea and a relaxed atmosphere.

Vallauris Golfe-Juan is renowned for its artistic heritage, particularly in ceramics and pottery. National Picasso Museum: War and Peace

NATURE

Paradou National Park:

The park is home to a variety of bird species, including the vibrant green parakeets and grey herons. Îles de Lérins:

Just a short boat trip from Golfe-Juan, the Lérins Islands are a must-visit for their stunning natural beauty and historical significance. The two main islands, Sainte-Marguerite and Saint-Honorat, offer lush forests, clear waters, and ancient ruins. Sainte-Marguerite is famous for its Fort Royal and the mystery of the Man in the Iron Mask, while Saint-Honorat is known for its monastery and vineyards. The islands provide excellent hiking trails, picnic spots, and opportunities for swimming and snorkeling.

Parc Exflora:

Located in nearby Antibes, Parc Exflora is a beautiful botanical garden that showcases Mediterranean plant species.
